Albert's work has become increasingly difficult as outlined in his report on the Mission Partners' noticeboard at the back of church. Any support you can give would make a great difference to his traumatised people. Please note that the **next Prayer Meeting will be held on Wednesday 20th March**, at 8pm in the Upper Hall, when we shall be focussing on prayers for our Mission Partners.
