


Discussions Sheet/ Youth

Reflection Round

Enjoy some family tea and tales time with the following conversation starters!

1. What does 'fellowship' mean, and what does it mean to you?
2. What are some of the benefits of having a community?
3. What would it look like if we were also eating with a 'glad and generous' heart?
4. How does it make you feel that so many people decided to become followers of Christ? Is it really worth it?
5. How does this story affect our own hearts towards other Christians, and towards those that are in need around us?

Answers

1. Some of the new followers were baptized.
2. The new followers devoted themselves to the apostles teaching and fellowship; in the breaking of bread and prayers.
3. Everyone was amazed because many wonderful things were being done by the apostles.
4. Spent much time together in the temple, they broke bread at home, ate with gladness, and praised God and had goodwill of all people.
5. They had glad and generous hearts.

Bonus Round Answer: There were about 3,000 new followers (Acts 2:41).
