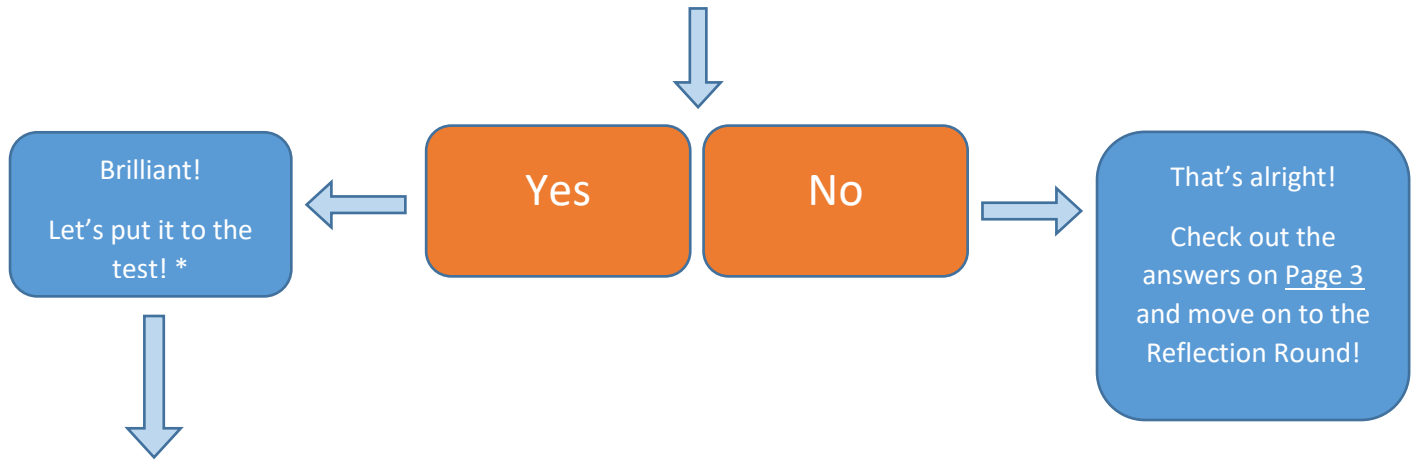


Discussions Sheet/ Youth
